"Fool for Christ" Comes to Las Vegas A One Woman Play with Sarah Melici as Dorothy Day, Friday, Aug. 3, 7 pm

"When Dorothy Day died in 1980 at the age of eighty-three it was observed that she was "the most influential, interesting, and significant figure" in the history of American Catholicism. The Catholic Worker, a lay movement she founded in 1933 and oversaw for nearly fifty years, was an effort to show that the radical gospel commandment of love could be lived. She understood this challenge not just in the personal form of charity (the works of mercy) but in a political form as well, confronting and resisting the social forces which gave rise to such a need for charity. She represented a new type of political holiness— a way of serving Christ not only through prayer and sacrifice but through solidarity with the poor and in struggle along the path of justice and peace."
